This translates to providing authoritative and expert advice and conducting high level dynamic risk assessments to ensure that a balance is achieved between protecting public safety and public interest whilst being fair and compassionate to registrants whose practice is being examined. This work has also led me to deliver specialist simulations to students across the School of Health and Care Professionals about professional regulation and accountability which have always been well evaluated.
