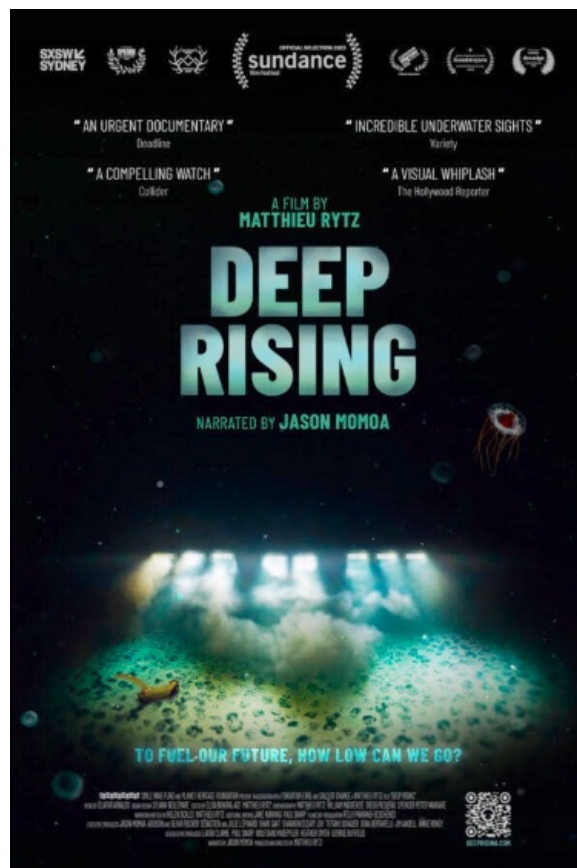
Screening of the "Deep Rising" documentary
